DEACON'S CORNER.....

What an exciting few months it's been for me! I've graduated from seminary, been commissioned as a deacon in the United Methodist Church, and have begun my appointments to clinical pastoral education (CPE) and Chalfont UMC. What does that mean in English? It means I can finally begin an active ministry combining community-based chaplaincy with my work in the local church! I'll continue as worship leader at the 11 a.m. service with our fabulous band, Beacon, and add some new programs working with children and with older adults.

I'm particularly excited about our community outreach project, "The Koffee Klatch: an Alzheimer's Café." Based on a model of care in the Netherlands that was brought to the US in 2008 by Dr. Jytte Lodvig, Ph.D., an Alzheimer Café is unlike the traditional support group offered in many communities. Rather than address the needs of persons with dementia and their caregivers separately, the Alzheimer's Café provides a positive experience for families to enjoy together. In a warm and accepting environment, new memories are made while cherished ones are recalled; new friendships are formed while family bonds are enhanced. Coffee, conversation, and purposefully designed activities allow families with dementia to step out of the rigors and stress of the day to day and into a few of hours of gentle respite once a month.

In addition to my work directly with the Café, I'll be moving out into the community letting local agencies, nearby churches, existing support groups, and nursing facilities know about our unique ministry to older adults. If you as a member of Chalfont UMC have any connections with community organizations that I might explore, I hope you'll let me know.
